

# ATTENTION CONSIGNORS:

It is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to list the **WORKING CONDITION** and **PHYSICAL CONDITION** of the item(s) you are dropping off for consignment. If you **DO NOT** list the working / physical condition on the descriptive index card attached to your item, you are guaranteeing that the item works / runs and is in good physical condition. If your item is found to be non-working / not working well or below average physical condition, ***it may be refused by the winning bidder.***

- ◆ If you are unsure whether or not your item works / runs, please write **“Unknown Working Condition, As Is”** on the descriptive index card attached to your item. If you do not want your item to be listed “As Is,” you will need to test it yourself before / when dropping the item off.
- ◆ If you choose **NOT** to test an item before dropping it off (but you’re confident that it works / runs), you may list that it “Worked When Last Used” or “Worked When Removed” (with a time indication... “6 Months Ago” ... “5 Years Ago” ...). However, if the item is purchased / tested and found to be non-working (or not working well), ***it may be refused by the winning bidder.***
- ◆ If you know that something is wrong with an item, make sure to note it on your descriptive index card. If you fail to note an important detail about the working condition or physical condition of an item, ***your item may be refused / returned by the winning bidder.***

**NOTE:** There is **NO GUARANTEE** concerning the working condition or physical condition of “As Is” items.
